We are working on a project entitled ***“Smart Home Technology as A Platform to Implement Cognitive Interventions to Facilitate Safety and Independence Within the Homes of Individuals with Traumatic Brain Injury: First Steps Towards a Multi-Site Trial in Ontario”***.

This project is funded by the CTRC and the ONF-REPAR and has received ethics approval from the REB at Baycrest.
