Fair and timely access to auto insurance benefits after injury is important to everyone in Ontario. This is especially true when a person has a brain injury from an auto collision. We are graduate students at **McMaster University** working in collaboration with **Acquired Brain Injury Survivor Solutions (ABISS)**, a group of individuals who have brain injury due to motor vehicle collisions.

The members of **ABISS** are an advocacy group of individuals with lived experience of brain injury and auto insurance processes. These individuals acted as a consulting group who understand what it is like to go through the process but who are objective in the sense that they are no longer involved in auto insurance claims or active rehabilitation. They assisted in survey design and distribution and they completed a trial survey to ensure that it was accessible for participants. **The results of this trial survey will not be included in the final data set.**

Together, we have created a **survey to learn more about the experiences** that people with brain injury caused by motor vehicle collision have with **insurance claims**.

This survey is being conducted by researchers at McMaster University. Someone on your therapy team might have told you about the survey. This survey is **not** part of your therapy. **You choose if you want to do it.** Please do it at home, not in therapy.
